- Going to start preparing "impact debriefs" after large fundraising events

PRINCIPAL AND LSC UPDATES

- Discussed Match campaign funding and goal (details under New Business)
- Mrs. Racasi sent letter home to Pulaski families discussing budget shortfalls and how FOP is helping. Mentioned that all fundraising efforts need to be supported.

PROJECTS AND PROCUREMENT

- Follow up on damaged whiteboards.
 - o Some were damaged likely from the manufacturer
 - Need to hear back from teachers before going back to supplier
- Technology Needs Assessment from Mr. W. and Ms. Natale

- o 3 document cameras for new classrooms
- o Chrome books for new 3rd and 4th grade
 - 6 for new 4th grade classroom
 - OR 7 additional to fill a 3rd grade cart and 14 additional to fill 4th grade cart
- o iPad minis plus cases
 - 6 iPad minis plus cases for new 1st grade classroom
 - Pulaski has 15 loose iPads. If the school had 15 more we could have a full cart that could be checked out. The school does already have the cart
- o 4 projectors (2 classrooms don't have working ones, need 2 backup ones)
- o 5 sets of classroom speakers
- o Computers in the design lab are outdated and unable to hold current software
- o Design lab laser cutter -- Mr. W. has started fundraising for this
- Teacher laptops school budget should cover these of FOP would have to donate funds to Pulaski because they need to be purchased through CPS.
